The KERN EQUITABLE MAP COALITION will Propose  
2021 Kern County Board of Supervisors District Map**

**BAKERSFIELD, CA — On Tuesday, September 7, 2021 at 6pm, the Kern County Board of Supervisors will convene the Second Public Hearing in the 2021 Redistricting Process for Kern County.**

The KERN EQUITABLE MAP COALITION will present the Equity Coalition Map of Kern County Board of Supervisors districts. Based on 2020 Census data, the EQUITY COALITION MAP reflects the significant increase in populations of Kern County's communities of color. The Equity Coalition Map includes three (3) Latino-Majority districts to reflect Kern County's current demographics and can be viewed at <https://arcg.is/158OvL0>.

The KERN EQUITABLE MAP COALITION is a coalition of Kern Residents and organizations whose goal in the 2021 redistricting process is **EQUITABLE MAPS in Kern County**.

This [FIRST EQUITY COALITION MAP](#) proposal for the Kern County Board of Supervisors was created by the Kern Equitable Map Coalition using over 200 Community of Interest Surveys, weekly redistricting education and engagement with Kern Residents, and [Equity Indicators](#). This information, along with 2020 Census data has been compiled by Demographer and Statistician Jesus Garcia of La Cresta Demographics, following all guidelines of the Voting Rights Act and the California Fair Maps Act. Partisan data and incumbent residences were excluded from consideration.
